- \*\*New Rally Driver will not be permitted in other Professional Class unless he/she completes 3 races in the Production class categories.
- Tempered / Punched Engine vehicle shall be disqualified and Tinted glasses will not be allowed.
- Please enclose vehicle registration copy or Bill of landing (B/L). No vehicle will be allowed to participate in the rally without prevision of mentioned documents.( Please read detail Rulres).

- Only following Upgrades are allowed in Stock/Production Category:

  Shock Absorber: Single aftermarket Shock Absorber (with reservoir without bypass) fitted to the original mounting points without any alteration to the original bracket.
- **Springs:** Aftermarket Springs are permitted but they must mount in OEM brackets. **Snorkel:** Snorkel can be installed in Stock Category vehicles.
- Skid Plate: Skid plate is allowed.
- Rally Seats for Driver & Co Driver with 4-point hardness: These can be installed if the Driver prefers.
- Tires & Rims: Tire sizes and Rims can be changed.
- Transmission Oil Coolers: Aftermarket Transmission Oil Coolers are allowed.
- Exhaust: It is now mandatory to have stock exhaust with muffler.
- ECU: Remap allowed only, to avoid doubt no other modification allowed to the internal and external of the engines.
- Steering Wheel: After Market is allowed.
- Bumpers: Front and rear bumpers can be replaced with aftermarket or customized bumpers.

There shall be minimum05 vehicles in each category. In case of Less than 05 Vehicles in a Category the Vehicle shall be combined with upper category of Prepared/Stock

### Important

- Once participated in any category No Driver or Co-Driver and Vehicle shall take part in any other category.

  The special category for Female drivers; minimum vehicles restriction will not apply on it.

### iii. Rally Route

- i. The TDCP Cholistan Desert Rally is day rally comprises on Four stages of the rally Track for Prepared Category and Two stages for Stock
- ii. The registered Service Vehicles, if any, will also follow the Rally Route. However, the service vehicles will be allowed onto the Rally Route only after all competing vehicles have started on the section.
- iii. The organizers will strive to keep ordinary traffic off the Rally Route, but participants must be cautious of any other traffic on the Route.

### Technical/Safety Inspection

All participating vehicles as well as service vehicles must pass technical/safety inspection on the following points prior to the Rally.

- ROLL BAR and FIRE EXTINGUUISHER are MANDATORY for all vehicles.
- Driver and Navigator Uniform (Protective clothing/suit/jacket/ pants/Coverall) are MANDATORY. ii.
- All loose items inside and outside the vehicle must be removed. Any item carried in the vehicle must be bolted or securely fastened. iii.
- Snap-on hubcaps, detachable fender skirts, and trim rings must be removed.
- v. Wheels must be safely affixed. They shall not be reversed so that lughole taper does not mate with the chamfer of the lugs. All studs and lug nuts must be present and functional.
- Tyres must be in good condition, with no cord or belts showing or cracks in the tread of sidewall.
- vii. Seatbelts must be properly installed with attached hardware secure and tight.
- viii.
- Throttle return action shall be safe and positive. No fuel, oil, water, or brake fluid leaks should be observed when the engine is running. ix.
- No cracks shall be permitted in cast or forged wheels.
- хi. Brakes must have an adequate pedal, sufficient fluid in the master cylinder and no apparent leaks under pressure and must operate on all wheels.
- Wheel bearings, shocks, steering and suspension shall be in good operating condition. xii.
- xiii. All lights, horn and rearview mirror(s) must be functional.
- xiv. Batteries shall be attached securely to the frame or chassis structure in such a way as to ensure that the battery will remain in place.
- xv. Extra fuel tank if needed should be properly affixed and fastened.

### **General Conduct of the Event**

- All participants must consciously display good sportsmanship and a genuine concern for safety. Failure to do so or failure to obey official instructions will lead to disqualification / removal from the rally.
- On Rally route, Rally vehicles wishing to overtake must be allowed a safe opportunity to overtake at the earliest. ii.
- Helmets and seat belts must be worn at all times while competing on the rally route.

  Mobile as well as stationery officials will be placed all along the rally route to observe rally vehicles. iii.
- iv.
- Repairs and service of rally vehicles is freely allowed throughout the rally route, however, participants must ensure that the rally route is not v. obstructed in any manner.
- Any delay caused by mechanical failure, drive/Co Driver error, mishap, or whether etc. will be the sole responsibility of the rally crew and no vi. allowance of any sort will be permitted.
- vii Any accidents / mishaps must be immediately reported to the nearest rally official/Check point.
- The organizers reserve the right to delete, add, or change any part of the route or event regulations at any time should they deem fit. Refueling is permitted at rally route; however, no extra time allowance of any sort would be permitted on such grounds. viii.
- ix.
- The rally will use the 24-hour format for Time management.
- xi. Rally number will only be allotted after confirmed payment

Penalties Any vehicle reporting late at start point shall be penalized @ 10 Seconds for every minute that it is behind its scheduled time. Any vehicle arriving at lineup for more than 30 minutes late shall be disqualified. Penalties may be enforced to all those who shall fail to follow the announced Route/Track and deviate beyond the limits announced by the organizers .The decision of the Time Management Committee shall be final and cannot be argued/challenged.

The penalty for these infringements may be reduced from total disqualification to a time penalty of 45minutes at the discretion of organizers.

I/we absolve the Rally Organizers from any liability in case of any mishap. I/we have read the rules & regulations and undertake to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Rally. Information provided is correct and I/we undertake responsibility for any penalty imposed for wrong information/entry. TDCP has

right to reject or accept any registration. I/we will accept the decision of organizing committee/jury and I/we will not pursue in the court of Law.
